Admission Procedure

Admissions are granted for boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status, depending on the number of vacancies in a particular class. Prospectus containing registration form is available at the school office from the first week of January. The registration fee is non-refundable and registration of a student does not guarantee admission.

Admission of a student to the school will mean complete acceptance of the school rules in force at the time of admission and all amendments, if any, thereafter. Admission are based on written tests as well as personal interview. Parents/guardians are required to bring the candidates to the school for written tests on the given date and time.

At the time of admission every student must produce transfer certificate from the school last attended. For admission to pre-primary classes, however, only the Birth Certificate from the local governing body has to be produced. The particulars of the candidate entered in the admission form must tally with those recorded in the T.C. Request for name, date of birth etc. will not be entertained.

Laboratories

Our students gain first-hand experience and gather information regarding laws of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in well equipped & furnished laboratories.

Physics Lab

A huge and spacious lab for physics is available here. It is equipped with various apparatus and science materials for about 40 students at a time. Practicals are regularly conducted under guidance of qualified Science teachers.

Chemistry Lab

We have a spacious lab with maximum accommodation for forty students at a time. It is enriched with ample of chemicals and different apparatuses. Students are trained to handle glass wares properly and conduct experiments successfully.

Biology Lab

We have a large and huge Bio-Lab with lots of equipments, electronic microscopes and computerized spots. Students are trained to measure B.P. and find out blood group etc.

School Transport

The school has a fleet of buses at its own disposal. The buses pick up the students from their stoppage from different areas of the city and nearby areas and drop them at the scheduled stoppage. Each bus driver has been provided with a cell phone for the convenience of contacting the driver at any point in case of urgency.

Bus Rules

1. All the students using the school buses are expected to be on the right side of their bus stop at least five minutes prior to the arrival time of the bus.
2. The buses will not wait for the late comers.
3. The children should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
4. No student should come near the entry door of the bus until it has made a complete halt.
5. All the students must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding their buses.
6. No student is allowed to eat anything inside the bus.
7. The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason whatsoever.
8. Bus facility cannot be withdrawn in mid session of the academic calendar.



Counselling

Performance and career based continual guidance is provided to the students parents through regular and systematic counselling by experts.

Almanac

Each student is given a Student's Diary at the beginning of the academic session. The diary contains school calendar, rules and regulations, school timings and serves as a medium for two-way interaction between parents and teachers.

Admission

Students are mainly admitted in Nursery only through a well-established admission process. However, a limited number of students are given admission to higher classes subject to availability of seats. The entry level into the school is decided by the age criteria as laid down by the CBSE. All admissions are granted purely on merit basis or by admission tests.

Fee Structure

Details of the existing fee structure are enclosed herewith and are also available in the school office. Fee structure is marginally revised every year to neutralize the inflation, increase in DA, increments in salary and keeping in view the future developments of the school.

Information for Scholars/Parents

General

1. Parents/guardians are requested to co-ordinate with the school authorities for the growth and proper development of their wards.
2. Parents are requested to encourage for self help in work and study at home. The children should be asked to do their works themselves like polishing their shoes, making their beds, keeping things tidy with care etc. The formation of such habits early in life inculcates in them the dignity of labor and self-reliance.
3. The children should also be taught general norms of good behavior at home. They should be asked to speak and be spoken politely by the parents.
4. Parents are requested not to meet any teacher or their wards in the school without prior permission of the principal; they are requested not to contact them on phone either. However they are welcome to meet the Principal from 9:00 am to 11:00 am on all working days.
5. All the students must have 80% of attendance, failing which they will not be permitted to appear in the examination. However, the school authorities reserve the right of condoning the shortage of attendance on merit.
6.
 - [i] If a student remains absent for three or less than three days, leave application must be addressed to the principal. It should be sent prior to going on leave.
 - [ii] In case of illness, for more than three days, medical certificate must be sent along with the application.
 - [iii] If a student remains absent for 3 working days without any leave application his/her name will be struck-off the rolls. He may be readmitted again only after the payment of readmission fee.
7. If any student breaks the discipline in the school parents will be informed by SMS system. If after two times reminder the student does not change his/her behavior, school management will be compelled to struck off his/her name from the school register and TC will be issued. In such cases no fee will be refunded.
